As Pierce County's fastest-growing industry, jobs in construction range from operating machinery on a steamy roadbed to designing floorplans in an air-conditioned office.

Construction jobs projected to grow at the fastest annual growth rate through 2023:

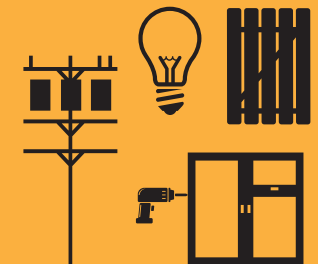
